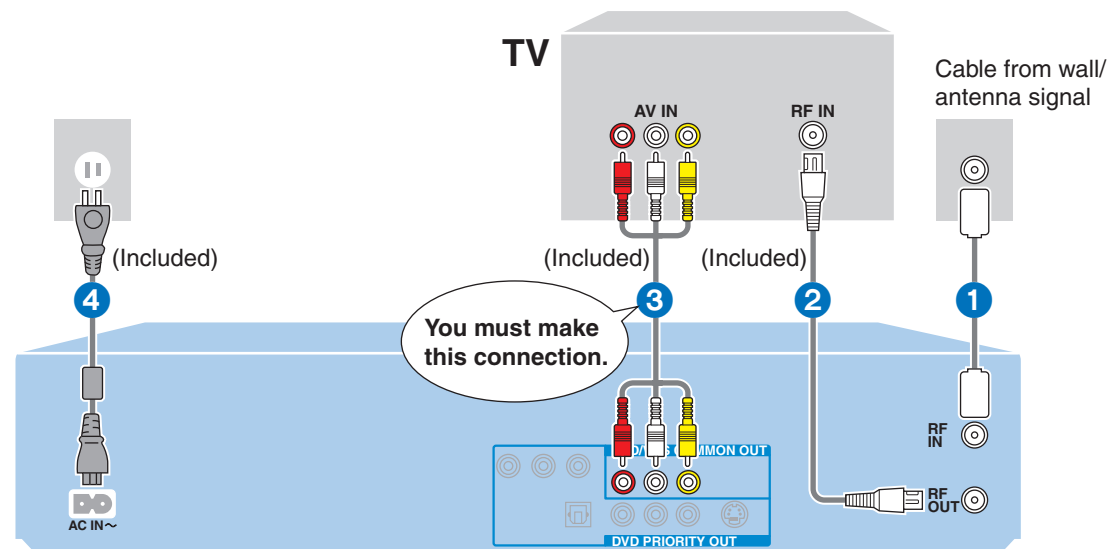

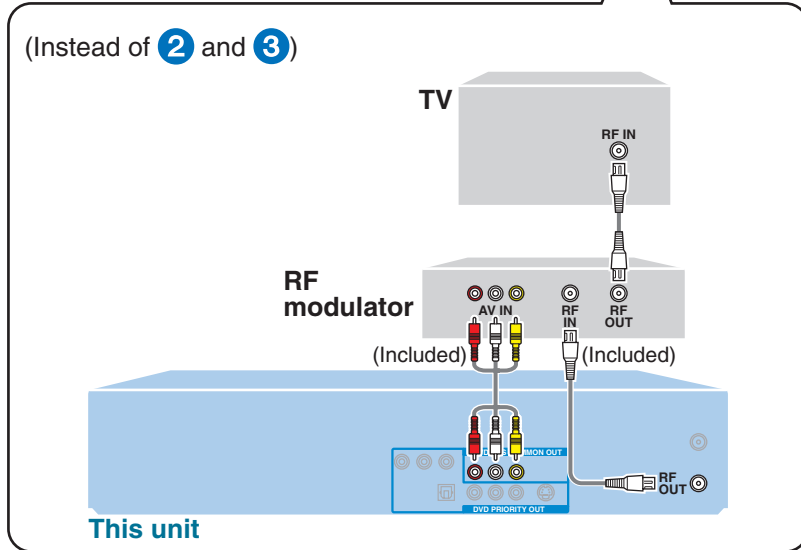

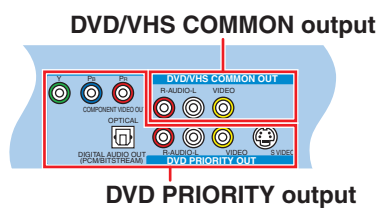

The unit has DVD/VHS COMMON output terminals and DVD PRIORITY output terminals.



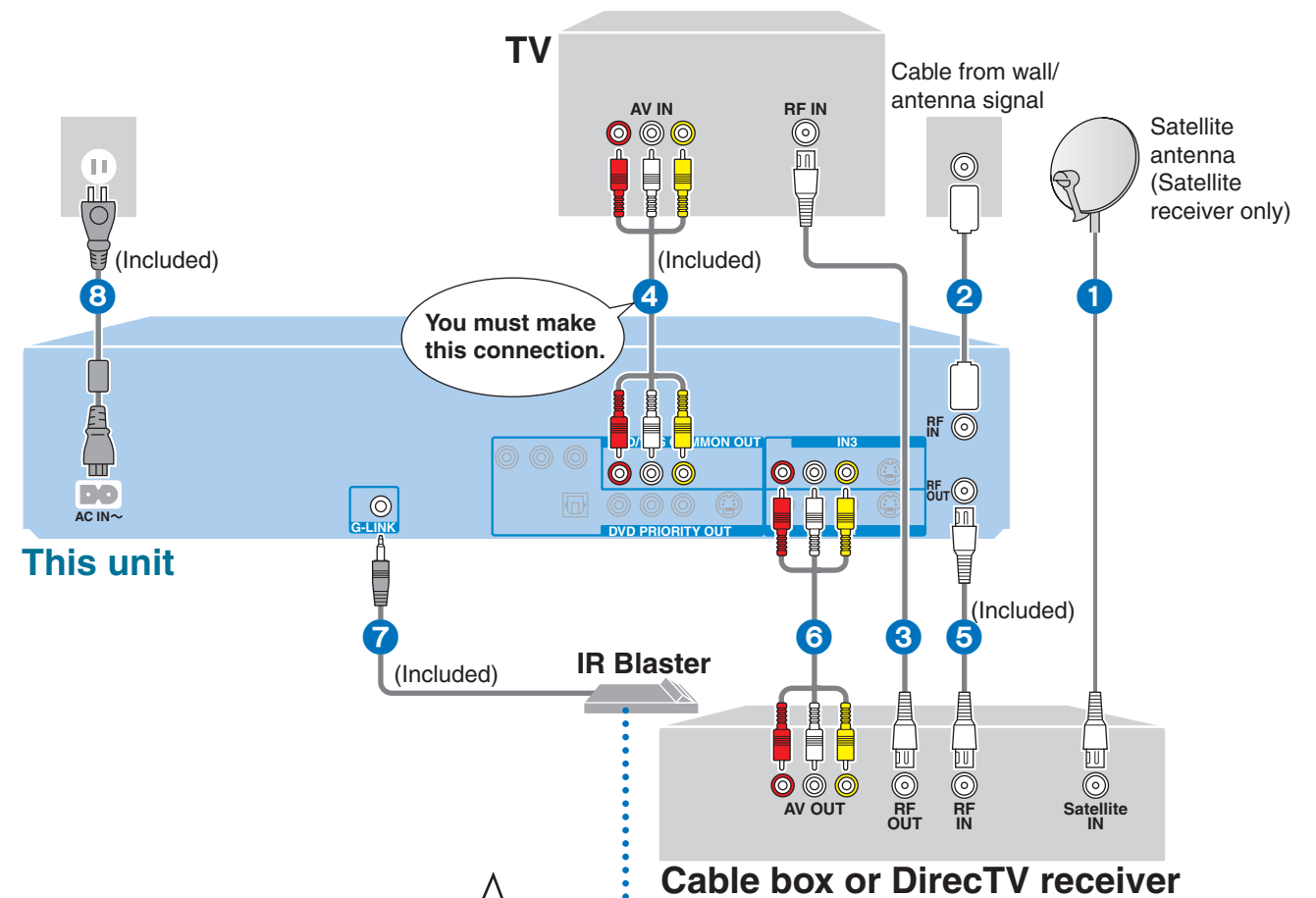
DVD/VHS COMMON OUT

For DVD/VHS COMMON output terminals, both DVD and VHS signals can be output.

DVD PRIORITY OUT

You can also playback a tape with the DVD PRIORITY output terminal except while recording, or making a scheduled recording, on the DVD.

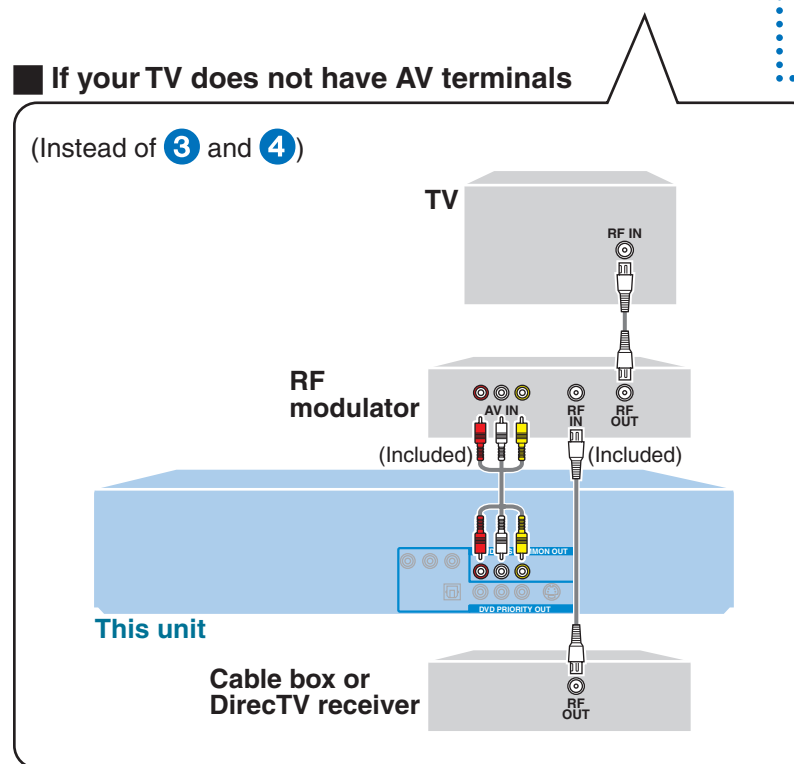

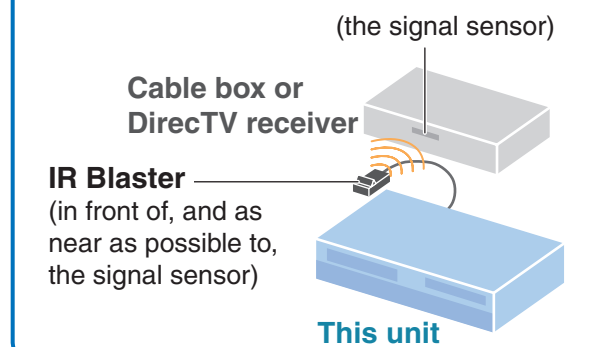

Connecting and positioning the IR Blaster

The IR Blaster is a device that allows this unit to communicate with the cable box or DirecTV receiver. If you connect a cable box or a DirecTV receiver to this unit, you also need to attach the IR Blaster.

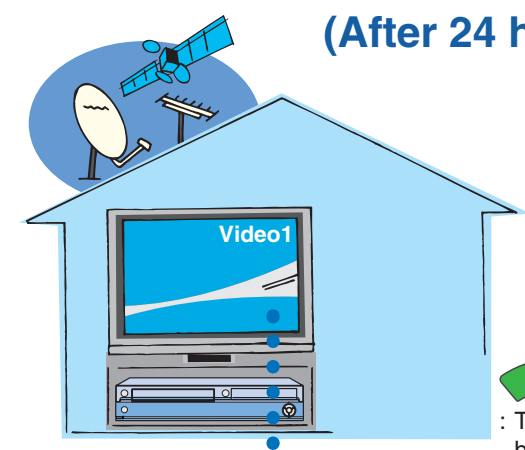


1 Turn this unit off and wait for 24 continuous hours!



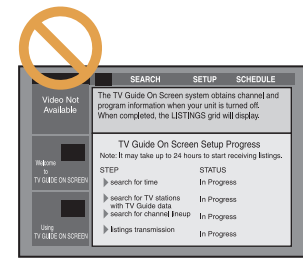
Check the following again

Note

- Leave the unit in standby mode when you are not using it. The unit will download the necessary data to maintain the program listings while it is in standby mode. After turning the power off, "BYE" appears briefly on the unit's display. This shows the unit is in standby mode.
- The first few days of listings usually appear within 24 hours after a successful Setup. It may take up to six days for the full eight days of program listings to appear.

Q : What is the TV Guide On Screen® system?

A : The TV Guide On Screen® system provides a free, interactive electronic program guide (EPG) for checking what's on. Setting up to record a program is easy too. Simply select the desired program from the displayed listings. You can also search for desired programs by category, by keyword, or alphabetically.

	Problem	Causes/Remedies
Connection	I've reviewed the diagrams Panasonic provides but I don't see one that illustrates my system. Should I assume that this DVD Recorder wouldn't be compatible?	Absolutely not! Program listings	No program listings available.	<p>Program listings will be downloaded when this unit is turned off. When not in use, turn this unit off.</p> <p>If connecting with a cable box or satellite receiver, these units must remain turned on to download program listings.</p> <p>In step 2(➔ 4), did you correctly set up the TV Guide On Screen®? (Check the connected cables, or antenna, the cable box or satellite setup, your ZIP Code, etc.)</p> <p>If the ZIP Code where you live has recently changed, it is possible that it hasn't been registered with TV Guide yet. If you have any questions contact: www.panasonic.com/dvdhelp/ 1-800-211-PANA (7262)</p> <p>During the first 24 hours, did you experience a power outage?</p> <p>The TV Guide On Screen® system is only available if using DirecTV, cable TV, or off-air reception using a rooftop antenna. 	I turned on the DVD Recorder, but the program listings were incomplete.	The first few days of listings usually appear within 24 hours after a successful Setup. It may take up to six days for the full eight days of program listings to appear.
	I've noticed that some channels carried by my cable company are not listed. Can they be added?	The TV Guide On Screen® system selects the channels they include based on market popularity and local viewing area statistics. Such statistics are constantly reviewed so it's possible that the number of channels carried in your area will increase. At this time you cannot manually add channels so that program listings will be included.
Operation	I'm trying to watch TV and the channels keep changing.	This unit may tune your cable box or DirecTV receiver to a specific channel to receive the TV Guide On Screen® program listings. The recorder will only do this when it is turned off. To ensure the DVD Recorder does not tune to receive program listings while you are watching TV, turn the DVD Recorder on and use the DVD Recorder to watch TV. Remember to turn the DVD Recorder off when not in use so it will receive program listings.

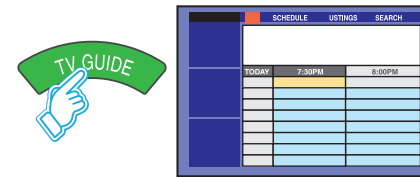

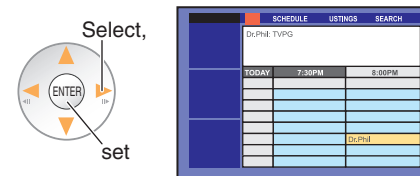

Making scheduled recordings to the HDD.

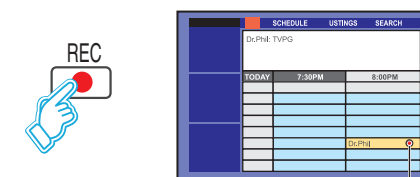
1 Display the program listings.

●: The settings are finished. (Scheduled recording begins when the set time is reached.)

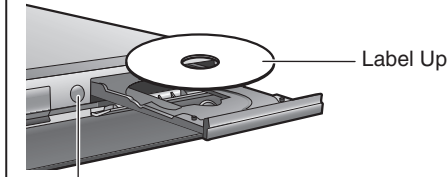

Copying from the HDD to a disc.

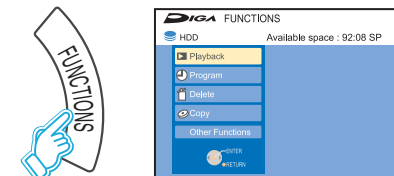
Preparation: Insert a disc.



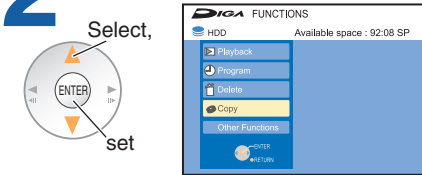
▲, OPEN/CLOSE

- DVD-R, DVD-R DL, DVD-RW (DVD-Video format), +R and +R DL are automatically finalized after copy.

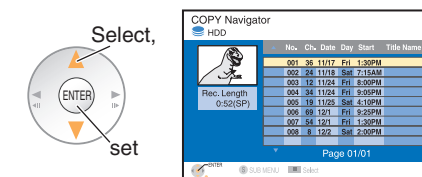
1 Display the Functions screen.



2 Select "Copy".

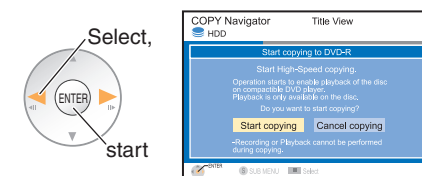


3 Select the program to copy.

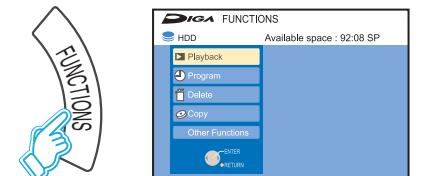
Delete

Delete unnecessary programs.

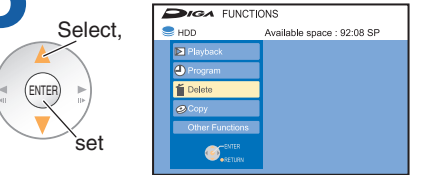
1 Select the drive (HDD, DVD or SD). (with the programs to be deleted)



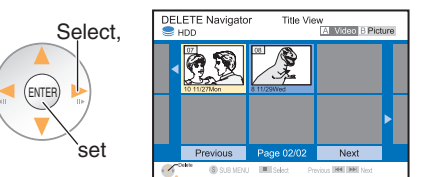

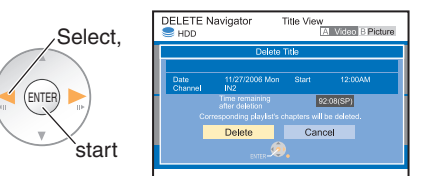

DVD-R, etc. recorded on this unit cannot be played on other players immediately after recording. Using the Finalize feature allows you to play these discs on other players. (However, once the disc is finalized you will no longer be able to record to the disc.)

Preparation: Insert the disc you want to finalize.
 Press [DRIVE SELECT] to select the DVD drive.

 - Finalizing takes up to 15 minutes.
