

Operating tips

Navigator key/Volume key (VOL., △)

- Scrolling through lists or items

 By pressing this key ([▲] or [▼]) repeatedly, you can scroll through (up or down) various lists or items.
- Adjusting the volume

 By pressing this key ([▲] or [▼]) repeatedly, you can adjust the receiver or speaker volume (up or down) while talking.
- Moving the cursor

Base unit: [A], [V], $[I \triangleleft A]$, or $[P \triangleright A]$ Handset: [A] or [V]

By pressing the above keys repeatedly, you can move the cursor to edit a number or name.

Soft keys

Each unit features 3 soft keys. By pressing a soft key, you can select the feature shown directly above it on the display. [MENU], [REDIAL], and other additional functions are assigned to the soft keys. Pay attention to the display to see what functions the soft keys are assigned during operation.








- 1 [MENU] \rightarrow [\pm][1][0][1]
- **2** Enter the current month, date, and year. \rightarrow [OK]
- 3 Enter the current hour and minute (12-hour clock format).
- **4** [AM/PM]: Select "AM" or "PM". \rightarrow [SAVE] \rightarrow [OFF]






Basic operations Making/Answering calls (Base unit/Handset)	
Answering calls	Base unit: Lift the corded handset, or press [SP-PHONE]. Handset: [♠]/[♠]
To hang up	Base unit: Place the corded handset on the cradle. When the speakerphone is used, press [SP-PHONE]. Handset: [OFF]
To adjust the receiver or speaker volume	Press [▲] or [▼] repeatedly while talking.
Making a call using the redial list	 [REDIAL] → [▼]/[▲]: Select the desired phone number. Proceed with the operation for your unit. Base unit: Lift the corded handset. Handset: [▼]
To adjust the ringer volume	 1 [MENU] → [♯][1][6][0] 2 [▼]/[▲]: Select the desired volume. → [SAVE] 3 Proceed with the operation for your unit. Base unit: [■] Handset: [OFF]
Phonebook (Base unit/Handset)	
Adding entries Making calls	 [□] → [ADD] Enter the party's name (16 characters max.). → [OK] Enter the party's phone number (24 digits max.). → [OK] [v]/[ʌ]: Select the desired group. → [SELECT] 2 times Proceed with the operation for your unit. Base unit: [□] Handset: [OFF] To enter a name, see the character table in the operating instructions. [□] → [v]/[ʌ]: Select the desired entry. Proceed with the operation for your unit. Base unit: Lift the corded handset.

Answering on/off	Press [ANSWER ON] to turn on/off the answering system.












Frequently asked questions Question Cause/solution Why is **Y** flashing? • The handset is too far from the base unit. Move closer. • The base unit's AC adaptor is not properly connected. Reconnect AC adaptor to the base unit. • You are using the base unit or handset in an area with high electrical interference. Re-position the base unit and use the handset away from sources of interference. • The handset is not registered to the base unit. Register it. • Press the navigator key [] repeatedly while talking. 












1 Cordless handset shows:

"No link. Reconnect base AC adaptor."

"No link. Reconnect base AC adaptor." is still displayed.

































Registering a handset to the base unit

The supplied handset and base unit are pre-registered. If for some reason the handset is not registered to the base unit, re-register the handset.

Handset

[MENU] \rightarrow [\ddagger][1][3][0]





Base unit

Press and hold [LOCATOR] for about 5 seconds until the registration tone sounds.

• The next step must be completed within 90 seconds.








Press [OK], then wait until a long beep sounds.





3 Use rechargeable Ni-MH batteries. (Alkaline/Manganese/Ni-Cd batteries CANNOT be used.)
