Press [▲], [▼], [◄], or [►] to navigate through menus and to select items shown on the display.




Press (▲) or (▼) repeatedly while talking.

The handset features 3 soft keys. By pressing a soft key, you can select the feature shown directly above it on the display.

[SELECT], **[SAVE]**, **[OK]** and additional other functions are assigned to soft keys. Pay attention to soft keys to find functions you need during handset operation.






Date and time (Handset)

- **3** Enter the current hour and minute (12-hour clock format) by selecting 2 digits for each.
- 4 Press [AM/PM] to select "AM" or "PM". → [SAVE] → [OFF]


Adding items to the phonebook (Handset)

- 4 [SAVE] \rightarrow [OFF]


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







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
Frequently asked questions		
Question	Cause/solution	
How can I increase handset volume level?	● Press [▲] repeatedly while talking.	
Why is the conversation noisy or cutting off?	 Try to relocate the base unit so that distance from location to use the handset will be minimized. 	
	 Send your unit to service, if your unit has same problem when the handset is next to the base unit. 	
Can I add another accessory handset to my base unit?	 Yes, you can add up to 8 handsets (including the handset(s) sold with KX-TG6700 or KX-TG6702 base unit) to a single base unit.

Can I keep battery charging all the time?	You can leave handset on the base unit or charger anytime. There is no damage to the battery.	
How can I answer a call- waiting call (2nd call)?	Press [CALL WAIT] when you hear call-waiting tone.

Quick troubleshooting

1 Handset shows:

"No link to base. Move closer to base, try again."

Place the handset on the base unit, then check if the charge indicator is on.


















2 No dial tone is heard from handset.

Lift up the handset from the base unit or charger. Press [] (TALK) at the handset, then check if the display shows "Talk".

Press [4] (SP-PHONE), then check if the dial tone is heard from the speaker on the back.


