

Setting up

Connections/Wall mounting



Note:

 The AC adaptor must remain connected at all times. (It is normal for the adaptor to feel warm during use.)

^{*2} The handset cover comes attached to the handset.

 Make sure that the wall and the fixing method are strong enough to support the weight of the unit.

Battery installation/Battery charging

Important:

- Use the supplied rechargeable batteries. For replacement, we recommend using the Panasonic rechargeable batteries noted in the base unit's operating instructions.
- Wipe the battery ends () with a dry cloth.
- Avoid touching the battery ends (+), -) or the unit contacts.
- Confirm correct polarities (+), (-).
- USE ONLY Ni-MH batteries AAA (R03) size.
- Do NOT use Alkaline/Manganese/Ni-Cd batteries.

Charge for about 7 hours.

• When the batteries are fully charged, "Fully charged" is displayed.



Note:

- When the language selection is displayed after installing the batteries for the first time, you can select your desired language.
 - $\{ \}$: Select the desired setting. $\rightarrow [SAVE] \rightarrow [OFF]$
- If the batteries are fully charged, but the operating time seems to be shorter, clean the battery ends (⊕, ⊖) and the charge contacts with a dry cloth and charge again.

Registering a handset to a base unit

1 Base unit:

Press and hold [LOCATOR] for about 5 seconds.

- Depending on the base unit, a registration tone sounds.
- If all registered handsets start ringing, press [LOCATOR] again to stop, then repeat this step.

2 Handset:

Place the handset on the base unit or charger, then wait until a long beep sounds and Ψ is displayed.

Note:

 If an error tone sounds, or if \(\mathbf{Y} \) is displayed, register the handset according to the base unit's operating instructions.

Display language

- 1 [MENU]#110
- 2 (\updownarrow): Select the desired setting. \to (SAVE) \to (OFF)

For your safety

Power connection

- Completely insert the AC adaptor/power plug into the power outlet. Failure to do so may cause electric shock and/or excessive heat resulting in a fire.

Installation

Installation and location

 The AC adaptor is used as the main disconnect device. Ensure that the AC outlet is installed near the product and is easily accessible.

Battery

- We recommend using the supplied batteries or additional/replacement batteries noted in the base unit's operating instructions for replacement battery information. USE ONLY rechargeable Ni-MH batteries AAA (R03) size.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not open or mutilate the batteries. Released electrolyte from the batteries is corrosive and may cause burns or injury to the eyes or skin. The electrolyte is toxic and may be harmful if swallowed.
- Exercise care when handling the batteries. Do not allow conductive materials such as rings, bracelets, or keys to touch the batteries, otherwise a short circuit may cause the batteries and/or the conductive material to overheat and cause burns.
- Charge the batteries provided with or identified for use with this product only, in accordance with the instructions and limitations specified in this manual.
- Only use a compatible base unit (or charger) to charge the batteries. Do not tamper with the base unit (or charger). Failure to follow these instructions may cause the batteries to swell or explode.
