When using external video source, such as Cable/Satellite box or DVD player, check that device is working. Why does my picture quality not look like it is in High Definition?	⊘	 Press INFO button on remote to confirm type of signal being received. HD signal should be 720p, 1080i or 1080p. Select a High Definition channel from HD source (Cable, Satellite, Fiber optic or antenna). HD channels sometimes broadcast non-HD content. Ensure that HD source (HD box, Blu-ray player, etc.) is connected to TV via either HDMI or Component cable and set to output HD video signal. 	
Why did the network connection fail?	•	 If connection fails, contact your Internet service provider or router/modem manufacturer to check for firewall, content filter or proxy settings that may block TV from accessing the Internet.
